Acorn Hall is a well-preserved example of Victorian Italianate style residence built in 1853. It is currently owned by the Morris County Historical Society and operated as a historic house museum. Major restoration work was completed in 1995.

The 2003 grant funded the scraping and repainting of the exterior.

Two 2010 grants will provide for stabilization of the 1860 dining room bay window, as well as the preparation of a Preservation Plan for Acorn Hall, the Carriage House and site.

Having completed the Preservation Plan, two 2011 grants will assist with the completion of a Landscape Plan, as well as Construction Documents for restoration of porch roof and balustrade, addressing structural deficiencies, and the design of barrier-free entrance to the first floor
