The Schuyler-Hamilton House, also known as Dr. Jabez Campfield House, is significant for its association with Alexander Hamilton, as the place where he courted Betsy Schuyler, during the winter of 1779-80 when the Continental Army was at Jockey Hollow. The house is now individually listed on the New Jersey Register of Historic Places.

The 2005 grant provided for the preparation of a Preservation Plan and Historic Register nomination.

The 2006 grant will address structural repairs and roof work.

The DAR Morristown Chapter will use the 2009 grant toward the reroofing of the rear porch, interior plaster restoration, exterior painting and framing assessment.
